

Wildcat Edge Andale

If Plan "A" doesn't work, go to Plan "B." After watching Andale's Tracy Lind gun in 20 of his team's 29 first-half points, Mulvane basketball coach Charlie Mason figured it was time for Plan "B."

"We tried to put a combination on him (Lind) in the first half but that didn't work so we changed to a 2-1-2 zone and it seemed to frustrate him," said Mason.

That move enabled the Wildcats to pull away for a 60-59 victory Friday night, Dec. 21, at Andale.

"It was a tight ball game, close all the way," said Mason. "It shouldn't have been, though. We had an eight-point lead in the third quarter but let it slip away. We built it (the lead) up with good, solid defense and going down and hitting some buckets."

Veteran senior Mark Storey did much of the hitting, as he finished with a team-high 22 points. Mark Smith scored

16 points and guard Jeff Staska found the range for 11 points, as the Wildcats improved their record to 3-2 heading into the Christmas layoff.

Smith and Storey also paced the Cats on the boards, although Andale recorded a 35-32 edge in rebounding. The 6-foot-2 Smith finished with 15 rebounds and Storey had 10.

"It was a good win," admitted Mason, who is in his first year as the Mulvane boss. "Anytime you win on the road, it's a good one. We had some highs and some lows. Our foul shooting, again, was a high. The last two games we've hit them pretty good."

Mulvane finished with 18 of 23 from the line, a figure which won the game, considering Andale made four more field goals than the Wildcats.

Smith iced the victory after the Indians missed a bucket and a chance to take a one-point lead with four seconds left. Smith got the rebound and was fouled, making both free throws to give Mulvane a three-point cushion.

The B-team squandered a big lead and lost a 44-42 game to Andale. High for the junior varsity was Brent Iverson, who finished with 15 points.

The Wildcats will be idle until Friday, Jan. 4, when they will host Buhler.
