

Wildcats Down Fredonia, 67-52

The Mulvane high school Wildcats won the first round of the holiday double header they participated in when they beat Fredonia on their home court Tuesday night by a score of 67 to 52.

The Wildcats moved out to a 17 to 10 first quarter lead, but by halftime they led by only two points 30 to 28. Coming back after the intermission Mulvane increased their lead in the third period, and then put on their strongest scoring splurge of the game in the final quarter to win by a comfortable margin.

Six Wildcats, who saw action in the contest, all scored in double figures, with Ted Richardson leading with 14 points. Other scoring was: Steve Carmichael, Gordon Long and Steve Roney all with 11 points each, and Mickey Davey and Bruce Kimble, who had 10 points each.
