That left the Wildcats with a 7-11 mark heading into a doubleheader against Circle Friday, May 13, at the Mulvane sports complex in their regular season finale. It will be the team's final tune-up prior to the regional tourney, which opens next week.

The loss spoiled a fine pitching effort by freshman Jamie Wilson, who held the Orioles to three hits and exited after five innings with a 4-2 lead.

The Cats jumped ahead early when Lee Cates walked and Heather Taylor singled to start something in the first inning. Cates scored when Shannon Reed belted a single and Taylor trotted home when Marianne Smysor singled.
