Still Tad Short

The Mulvane High School girls cagers played some of their best ball of the season Saturday night, Feb. 7, at Wellington, but Coach Rod Cole's basketballers were no match for the host Wellington girls in a make-up game in the Chisholm Trail League. The Lady Dukes decked the Cats, 78-44.

The loss was the 12th in 14 games for the MHS this season. Their next game will be at Buhler Friday night, Feb. 13.

One night earlier, Augusta was in town for another CTL loop contest and plowed down Mulvane, 62-28.

Meanwhile, the Mulvane junior varisty squad posted its first victory of the season at Wellington by romping to a 50-34 edge on the strength of a 19-point fourth quarter. Augusta's jayvees clipped the Cats Friday night, 42-41, on a shot at the buzzer.

"At Wellington, we handled their press pretty well early and got some easy shots that just didn't fall," said Cole, who watched his Wildcat gals fall to 2-4 in the CTL. "Wellington has a good squad and just wore us down as the game progressed."

The Cats were in the game early, trailing only 12-7 at the first quarter break but Wellington got hot in the second quarter, scoring 25 points to open a 37-20 gap by intermission.

On the bright side, Mulvane enjoyed some of its best balance on offense with eight girls scoring. Guard Kim Prickett and forward Kandi Miller tied for scoring honors with eight points apiece. Junior center Kathy Saxton scored seven points and Angela Cox and Rhonda Reekie had six each.

Against Augusta, the varsity girls pulled down a season-high 42 rebounds (Saxton leading the way with 14 caroms) but Mulvane could manage only 24% from the field.

Saxton also scored a team-high 13 points. Prickett finished with four points and reserve Toni Wayman scored three.

In the jayvee game against Wellington, Karen Lewis had 12 points and 10 rebounds, both career-high marks, and Bridget Horton scored nine points and had eight rebounds.

The Cats won the game by hitting nine free throws in the final quarter on the way to a 19-point quarter.
