The Wildcats broke to an early lead, then rested up with a 37-33 win over one-time winner Wellington in a Chisholm Trail League contest.

"We just weren't ready to play," said Stinson. "The last two weeks, I felt like we were really starting to play some basketball, recognize some things and reacting to them but we didn't at Wellington."

Stinson's gals, playing some outstanding zone defense, pulled out to a 27-19 lead after three quarters before hanging on. "We started getting ragged but were able to hold on," said Stinson.

Junior Tawnya Infinger was the only Wildcat in double figures, scoring 10 points. Guard Jay Kilpatrick finished with seven points and Traci Lawless, a junior, scored six as the Wildcats whipped the Crusaders for the second time this season to improve their record to 5-11 and 2-5 in the Chisholm Trail League.

One night earlier, the Cats cut down Clearwater, 53-34, playing some good basketball. Last Thursday, Feb. 10, Augusta downed the Cats, 38-35.

Four players hit double figures in the victory over Clearwater--seniors Kilpatrick and Mary Cole had 11 each and Infinger and Melody Carey scored 10 each. Cole also scored 11 against Augusta.

The MHS junior varsity rang up a 3-0 record in the past week, upping its record to 10-3. The Cat jayvees whipped Wellington, 38-28, nipped Clearwater, 38-36, and trimmed Augusta, 39-28.

Against Clearwater, Lori Meek led the scoring with 14 points and Diane Mohney and Jill Quigley had five points each. Lisa Jones' 12-point effort led the Cats offensively against Augusta.
