

MHS Boys, Girls Take A Tumble At Goddard

The Goddard boys gained revenge and the Goddard girls maintained their mastery over the Mulvane girls in games played Tuesday night, Feb. 24, in Goddard.

The MHS boys handled the Lions in mid-January, 50-41, but it was a different story on the road. Goddard won by a 61-57 score.

Mulvane's Greg Flores scored a season-best 23 points to keep the Cats close. Zach Kimble dumped in 16. Gavin Snider scored six points and Nick Hansen added five.

The loss was the 5th straight for the MHS boys. It left their record at 2-9 in the Chisholm Trail League and 6-13 overall.

The Lions, who have lost only two games this season, steadily pulled away. By intermission, Goddard had a 20-13 lead, then put the win away in the last quarter.
