

Brown's 'Green' Troops

Showing Improvement

Green is Mulvane's school color and it's also the color for the Wildcat girls varsity basketballers. Coach Bill Brown could only lament his club's inexperience or "greenness" following a 57-41 setback at Maize Tuesday night, Dec. 8.

The loss dropped Mulvane's record to 0-2. Five days earlier, the Cat gals opened their season at home and were whipped, 76-36, by Andlae.

"We're just inexperienced," said Brown. "We're just so green. If we can continue to score points, we'll be okay because we're starting to play some defense and our sophomores aren't dropping their heads after something goes wrong. We've got to hang in there until that time."

Against Maize, junior Mary Cole turned in one of her best games. She scored 19 points and pulled down 11 rebounds as Mulvane out-boarded the Eagles. "Cole had an excellent game and so did (Nancy) Gehring," said Brown.

Gehring finished with eight points and guard April Bales added seven. Sophomore Debbie McIntyre scored five points.

The Wildcat junior varsity almost pulled out a victory before losing, 32-31, at Maize. Sophomore Tawnya Infinger scored 11 points, Gwen Reekie had eight and Diane Mohny added six.

The Cat gals slumped in the second half, especially the third quarter, and Andale rolled out to a comfortable lead.

"The shots didn't fall early in the third quarter and that made the difference," said Brown.

A young offense was led by the junior Cole, who finished 11 points, junior Nancy Gehring with nine points and sophomores Traci Lawless (seven) and Debbie McIntyre (five).

The Mulvane jayvee team had an early case of the jitters and never did climb back in the game after trailing 25-8 at halftime. Andale rolled to a 39-25 verdict.

Tawnya Infinger led the MHS jayvees with seven points and Diane Mohny added six. Lawless scored five points.
