Saxton, who hit 10-of-10 from the free throw stripe, rebounded from a poor first game by scoring 20 points, but she took only eight shots, making five. She also had eight rebounds. The only other Wildcat points came from guard Kim Prickett, who scored four points. Rhonda Reekie, who scored three, and Kandi Miller, who had one.

A victory over Nickerson would put the 0-2 Wildeats in the consolation championship game at 6 p.m. Saturday. Dec. 13. If Mulvane loses its semifinal, the girls will be at 3 p.m. Saturday in the consolation third place game.
